Taking the Worry out of Slurry

Slurry is a valuable resource if you can store and spread it effectively. But there can be significant challenges to managing slurry on your farm. Roofing and Rainwater

Excess rainwater in your slurry will increase your slurry storage requirement. No farm has unlimited storage space, so keeping the volume low and the quality high is important. Adding roofing over yard areas which collect slurry from livestock is just one way you can begin to combat excess volume. Your local CSF adviser can help you explore your grant options.

Slurry Storage

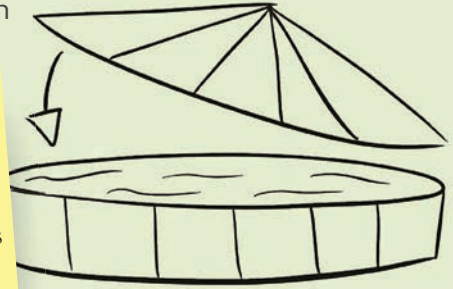
Investing in future-proofed slurry storage can help you make better use of nutrients, improve air and water quality and ensure you are compliant with regulations. A watertight cover on your store will ensure rainwater stays out and can reduce ammonia emissions by up to 80%.
